Rates & Policies Effective 2020-2021 School Year

Registration

Prospective students can call on (516) 220-7328 to register.
The school year is divided into two semesters of 19 lessons each plus one concert:
Fall (September - January & Spring (February - June).
No lessons on Christmas Week, Winter Recess and Easter Week.

Tuition Fees

Fees must be paid for each semester at the registration or at the time of the first lesson:

- 30 min. Lesson, once a week - \$1,000 per semester;
- 45 min. Lesson, once a week - \$1,500 per semester;
- 60 min. Lesson, once a week - \$2,000 per semester.

Arrangements can be made for an extended payment plan as follows:
50% of tuition fees at the registration with the balance due no later than
November 1, 2020 for the Fall semester & April 1, 2021 for the Spring semester.

Attendance

Weekly classes are a must in order to show good progress. Non-attendance of lessons due to illness will be rescheduled within the week. There will be no make-up lessons missed for any other reason except under special circumstances, which will be at the total discretion of the school. The teacher must be advised of any cancellation before 12 noon on the day of the scheduled lesson if the student is qualify for a make-up lesson. No refund or deductions can be made for any absence or vacation. Student attending single lessons that fail to notify the studio of non-attendance will be required to pay the cost of the lesson as a cancellation fee.

Summer

During the vacation months of July & August individual schedules can be arranged. This must be confirmed with the teacher by the end of June. Single lessons:

- 30 min. - \$50 per lesson;
- 45 min. - \$75 per lesson;
- 60 min. - \$100 per lesson.

Recitals

At the end of each semester students enrolled on the individual program will be given an opportunity to participate at the School Recital (January & June 2021). Students that show real commitment and promise will have the opportunity of performing at the Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, Symphony Space and other famous stages in New York City.
